- 1) Coach weak students
- 2) Look into open day and Parent-Teachers Feedback and do the needful
- 3) Check notes written by students

- 4) Homework schedule to be monitored
- 5) Those substituted should not demand for any book often than according to time table
- 6) Encourage students to participate in Intra school and Inter school competitions
- 7) All students should be given a chance to showcase their talents – Participation in assemblies and activities
- 8) Whats app group among students should be stopped
- 9) Heavy bags to be avoided – Students should be asked to bring books only as per timetable
- 10) Student participation in Sports and Games and coaching for the teams games should be taken care of
- 11) Students should be encouraged to actively engage themselves in the Olympiads
- 12) Importance should be given to handwriting
- 13) Reading should be practised for all subjects and on all days
- 14) Give assignments and activities to be done during week-ends.
- 15) Tamil reading and writing should be taken good care of because students find Tamil difficult to write
- 16) Give importance to value Education. Students must be taught morals and good behavior. Blend them with the lessons taught so that children do not find them tedious
- 17) Develop leadership qualities in students by giving them duties and charges to execute (i.e.) as class leader, row leaders, board incharge, discipline in charge, furniture incharge etc.
- 18) No corporal punishment of any kind should be implemented on any account. Students should be counseled and made to understand

what is right and what is wrong. Make them feel responsible and that will help change negative attitudes.

- 19) Teachers on duty during lunch break should go round and make sure that students complete their lunch. See that they bring vegetables everyday for lunch and Fruits, nuts and cereals and grams for snacks. Junk food should be discouraged.
- 20) Give importance to third language Hindi too
- 21) Encourage newspaper reading
- 22) Children with eye sight problems can be given the front seat. If they are tall you may ask them to occupy the side bench
- 23) Encourage and instruct students to do the activities on their own, without troubling their parents. Teacher should explain and make clear how the activities should be done
- 24) Have positive attitudes and be positive in your approach to students. Do not create impressions or misjudge them
- 25) Appreciate and applaud students even for their little acts of hardwork, kindness, understanding and adjustments
- 26) Teach spellings through syllabification to learning easy and comfortable
- 27) Those good at singing should approach Ms. Juliana. We need to have a School choir
- 28) Four teams that are formed should inculcate team spirit and understanding among the students. They should be taught to work with a competitive spirit and not with jealousy
- 29) Teachers should always keep in mind the safety of the students entrusted in their hands. Being a co- educational school, care should be taken to help students grow in a healthy atmosphere. They must be taught to mingle as brothers, sisters and good

friends. Teachers should be on the vigil during class hours and the breaks and see that nothing untoward happens in the school

- 30) Teachers should counsel to boys and girls separately regarding sexual harassment. Awareness should be created so that even at home and outside, the children are able to understand awkward situations face confidently and react correctly
- 31) Request the parents during the meetings and open day to be with their children when they browse on the internet for information. Using mobiles, laptops and computers in the absence of parents or elders may lead to corruption of young minds
- 32) Importance should be given to co- curricular and extracurricular activities
- 33) All kinds of problems – social, economical, political, medical, geographical, scientific, historical etc. should be brought to the notice of the students of grade 6 and above so that they grow in not only understanding problems but also in solving the problems in their own little way
- 34) Discipline should be the watchword in the school campus
